

Technician fourth grade (abbreviated **T/4** or **Tec 4**) was a <u>rank</u> of the <u>United States Army</u> from 1942 to 1948.^[1] The rank was created to recognize <u>enlisted</u>

soldiers with special technical skills, but who were not trained as combat leaders

Technicians represented a wide variety of soldiers with specialized technical skills, including medics, radio operators and repairmen, mail clerks, mechanics, cooks, musicians, and tank drivers
