Three Handley Page Halifaxes, photographed from an Avro Lancaster, can be seen over the target area, a coastal battery, which is obscured by low cloud. The scattered candles of a Target Indicator (TI) can be seen smoking on the beach, which is itself covered with landing obstacles.
