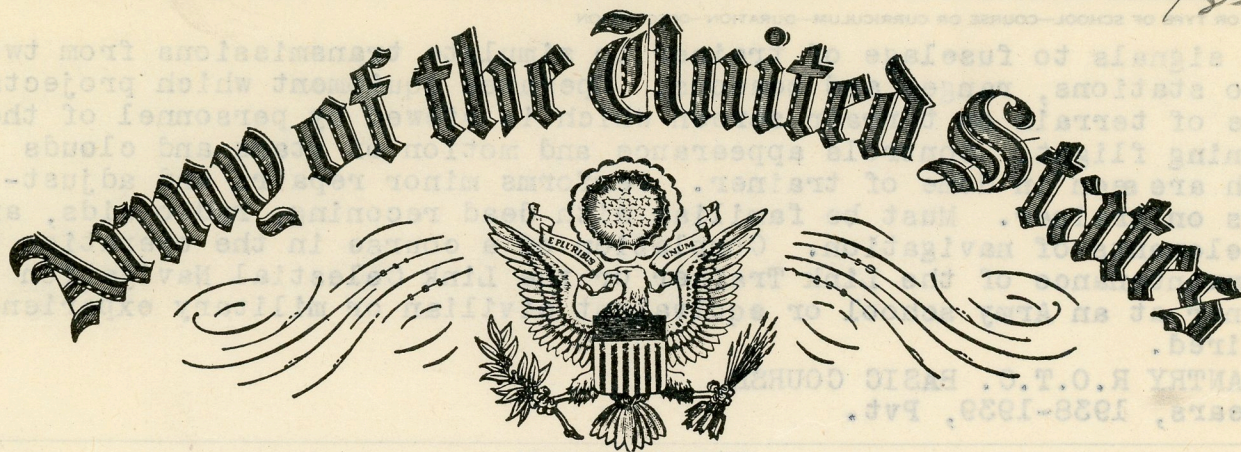

 LINK TRAINER NAV. OPERATOR (970) & LINK TRAINER INSTRUCTOR (658)
 Link trainer operation: Explains operation of equipment to trainee and demonstrate use of its controls and instruments and difference between operating characteristics of trainer and actual aircraft. Assigns a series of progressive practice exercises to trainee which includes simulated cross-country flights. During practice periods and test exercises, transmits simulated radio beam signals to trainee and operates equipment to give him flight instructions similar to those received in flight by radio from ground stations. Evaluates trainee's performance and maintains records pertaining to operation of the trainer. Inspects trainer prior to use and operates the controls in order to determine whether it is functioning properly. Cleans and makes minor adjustments to the trainer.
 CELESTIAL NAVIGATION TRAINER OPERATION: Follows track of flight-recorder across chart and coordinates movements of celestial dome with latitude and longitude of simulated aircraft. Trans-

mits signals to fuselage of trainer to simulate transmissions from two radio stations, ranges and beacons. Operates equipment which projects image of terrain on terrain screen which is viewed by personnel of the training flight. Controls appearance and motion of stars and clouds which are seen in dome of trainer. Performs minor repairs and adjustments on trainer. Must be familiar with dead reckoning, radio aids, and the elements of navigation. Completion of a course in the operation of and maintenance of the Link Trainer or the Link Celestial Navigation Trainer at an Army school or equivalent civilian or military experience required.
